

## QUICK GUIDE TO ASIA RE-OPENING (As of 07 December, 2022)

**\*Bolded Destinations are “Fully Open” to full vaccinated travelers (at least 2 doses <sup>(1)</sup>) with no testing, no quarantine, and no travel restrictions.**

(1)- Except in Japan, 2 doses and 1 booster shot are required for entering without covid testing.
